Show Bill – Schooling Shows | June 28, 2026

General Public Entry:

- Online registration closes one week before the show on Sunday, June 21.
- Outside riders may enter up to 2 jump divisions
- Day-of entries are accepted.
- Outside riders must be:
 - **For Walk/Trot:** Able to ride the patterns at a Walk and Trot safely.
 - **For Open Division:** Able to ride the patterns at a Walk, Trot and Canter safely.

Winton Woods Farm & Equestrian Center staff and the show judge reserve the right to refuse entry to any rider deemed unsafe. In such cases, the rider will be fully refunded for class entries.

Winton Woods Farm & Equestrian Center Student Entry:

- Register before online registration closes on Sunday, June 21.
- Participants must:
 - For WT Equitation/Horsemanship/Pleasure Classes:
 - Must be a current Advanced Novice or above student
 - For Poles Division:
 - Must be an Intermediate and above student
 - For Crossrails and above:
 - Have completed the subsequent class within the last year.
 - Be a currently active student.
- May only enter 1 jump division
- No cross entering permitted for WT and WTC classes.
- Day-of sign-entries are accepted for any student bringing their own horse.

Headgear/Vests:

- ASTM-certified helmets must be worn while mounted.

Dress Code:

- Proper riding boots with a heel should be worn when mounted.
- Jeans or Breeches are required.
- Official show shirts, jackets and apparel is encouraged
- Clothing displaying any vulgar, offensive or profane language or graphic is prohibited.

Health Papers:

- Outside horses must provide a negative Coggins and (if out of state) Health Certificate upon arrival.
- For the safety of all horses, no exceptions will be made.

Patterns:

- Showmanship/Equitation/Horsemanship patterns are posted day-of.
- Dressage Tests are located at usdf.org.

Warmup:

- The Indoor arena will be open for schooling at 8 a.m. (no lunging please) and will remain open for the duration of the show.
- The Jump Arena will be open for all riders to school until the poles division begins.
- The Flat arena will be open for lunging at 8 a.m. and remains open until the first class begins.

Cancellation Policy:

Entries canceled **at least 14 days prior to the show date** are eligible for a full refund. Cancellations received less than 14 days before the show are non-refundable, unless the entry can be filled from a waitlist or special circumstances are approved by show management. All cancellation requests must be submitted in writing via email to the show secretary or designated contact person.

Show Cancellation:

In the event the show is canceled by management due to inclement weather, facility issues or other unforeseen circumstances, competitors will be notified as soon as possible and refunds or credits will be issued at the discretion of show management.
